

### **Councillor Sian Gwenllian's report JUNE 2015**

- 1) **CUTS:** Gwynedd Council, like all councils, is going through a process of making cuts. I am attending a series of 5 workshops to discuss the possibilities before the public is invited to give its views. The Council needs to agree to £9M worth of cuts by March 2016.
- 2) **Church Hall:** I attended a constructive meeting to discuss improving the Hall and making use of the land at the back for community car parking.
- 3) **Steps leading down to Dock:** the Council has re-opened but have put safety measures in place at the bottom as there is still concern about public safety.
- 4) Cae Fodol Planning Permission for **Gypsy site:** up for discussion at Planning Committee 15.06.2016.
- 5) **Beach public toilets:** on-going discussions to improve whole area. 6) **Coastal Path:** on-going discussions.
- 6) **Tafarngrisiau Road :** improvement work on Council's list of priorities.
- 7) **School Playing field:** work to be undertaken over the summer to improve condition. Football Club do not intend to continue with application for synthetic pitch as unlikely to receive funding as similar facilities are being developed at Caernarfon.
- 8) **Paths at Hen Gei Llechi :** planning application to be submitted for the gates.
- 9) **Cae Rowen :** I have been to see local residents to get their opinion on the application to build 14 houses. Community Council has objected. **Rowen path:** Gwynedd Council waiting to hear if grant funding is available to improve path.
- 10) **Y Felinheli Language Group:** lots of work going on. A new video will be shown at Gwyl y Felin.
- 11) **Felinheli Festival :** I am on the committee. Programme will be distributed around village. Information on website : [www.gwylfelin.org](http://www.gwylfelin.org) and on Facebook village pages. Roads will be closed during Festival week. (details to follow)
- 12) **Swing for disabled children:** I have started discussions about the possibility of getting a new swing. We still await details of how much money will come from the solar park company at Parcia but buying a new swing could be effective use of the money.
- 13) **Dinghy Park at Beach Road :** the broken railings have been removed. Council will monitor use of area.
- 14) Great to see the 'snail ' on **20MPH signs** near Y Wern. Thanks to schoolchildren.
- 15) I continue to hold sessions at **Felin Sgwrsio** ( term-time) on Friday mornings 10.30 – 11.30. I send regular updates to [www.felinheli.org](http://www.felinheli.org) and Facebook Felinheli about village events and my work as councillor. Also started to distribute news-letter in the village as well as to large e-mail group.
