

## **Councillor Sian Gwenllian's Report July 2015**

**Tafarngrisiau Road:** Hogans will be re-surfacing the road on behalf of Gwynedd Council for a period of up to two weeks from July 27 onwards. Further information from Barry Naylor Williams on 01286 679760.

**Caernarfon/Bontnewydd by-pass:** improvements have been introduced near Crug which means that there will be local access. The latest map can be seen on the Community Council noticeboard in Felin Sgwrsio.

**Ffynnon Fair:** Alun Ffred Jones, AM has been in touch with Jones-Bros, the company implementing the by-pass scheme, noting concern about the historical well that could be buried. Following a site visit, I understand that efforts are to be made to safeguard the well.

**Map of Y Felinheli footpaths:** Launch at the Memorial Hall at 7, July 22.

**Caban Felin:** Open day at Glyn Lancaster Jones' workshop in Dinas on July 14 as part of Men's Sheds Cymru.

**Felinheli Festival:** many thanks to everyone for one of the most successful weeks ever!

**Ysgol Y Felinheli:** all the best to Non Huws who is retiring as head teacher. Her contribution towards our children's education and the life of our community has been immense.

**Rowen Planning Application:** the plan to build 14 houses is due to be discussed by the Planning Committee on July 27.

**Planning Application Cae Fodol :** this was rejected by the Planning Committee in June.

**Golygfa Menai Flats:** these are being marketed to local people first through Beresford Adams. Help is available for first time buyers through the Help to Buy scheme.

**Church House:** the Church has started the process of appointing an architect to draw up plans to improve the Hall and create a community car park at the back.

**Quay steps:** I am still trying to find a solution that will enable this public footpath to be re-opened. Concern remains about the safety of the public.
